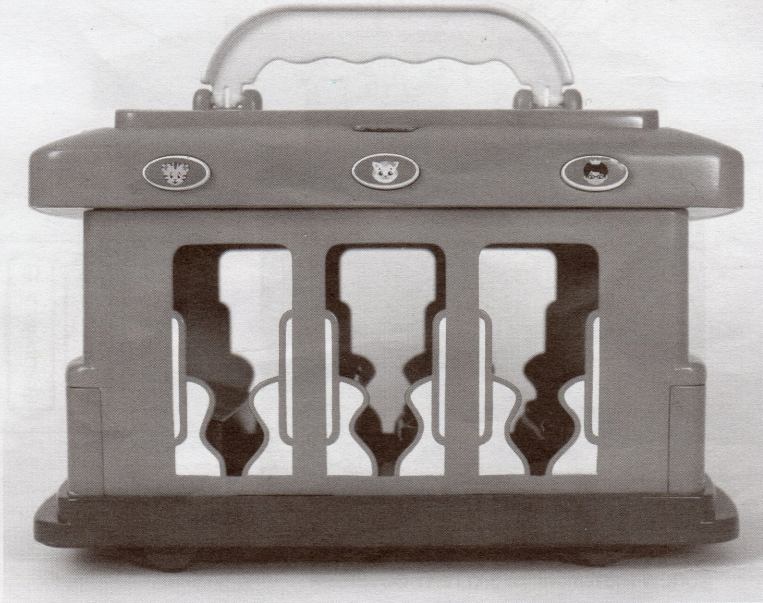

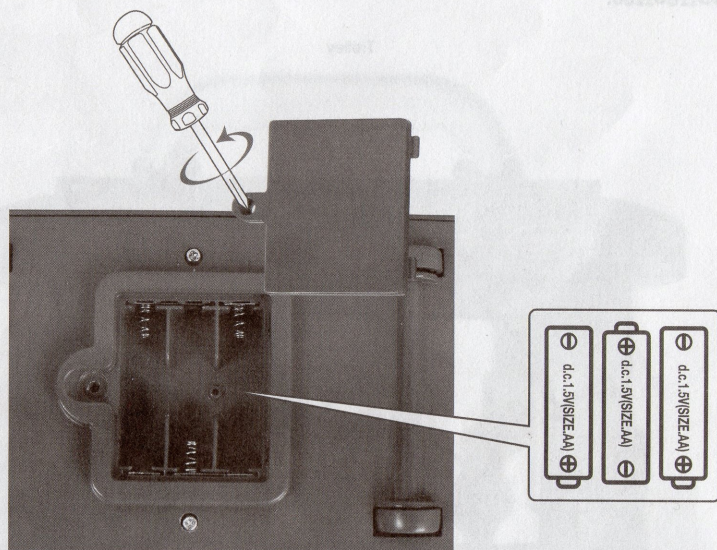
ADULT INSTALLATION REQUIRED

Requires 3 X 1.5V "AA" (R6) Batteries (included).

Batteries included are for "Try Me" purposes.

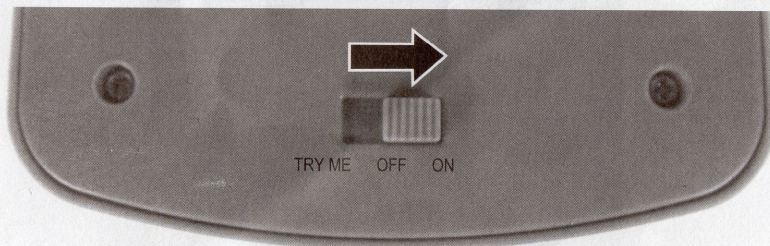
If performance diminishes after purchase, replace with fresh batteries.

1. Locate the BATTERY COVER on BOTTOM OF TROLLEY.
2. Using a Philips Head screwdriver, loosen the SCREW and remove the BATTERY COVER.
3. Install 3x 1.5V "AA" (R6) BATTERIES in orientation shown.
4. Replace the BATTERY COVER and tighten the SCREW.

2. To PLAY, slide the switch to the ON Position.

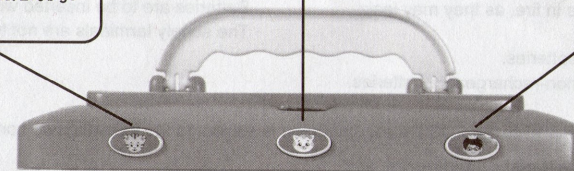

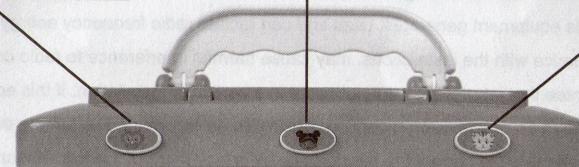

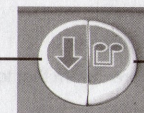

Press to activate the following:

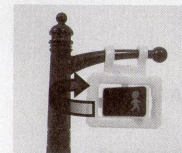
- Ding Ding Sound

- Light at Front



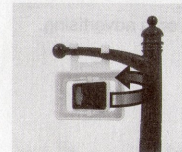
2 Alternating Songs:

- Safety Song

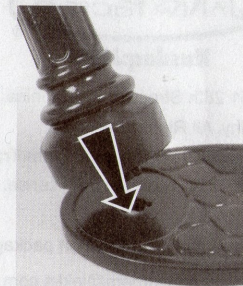
How To Use The Crossing Light



1) Turn the "STOP" sign clockwise.

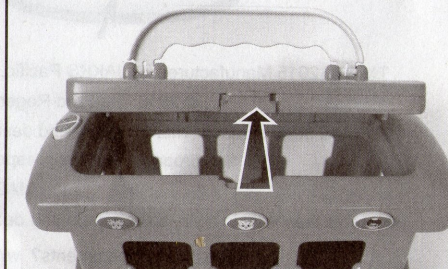


2) Turn the "GO" sign counterclockwise.



Hold base firmly and pull away crossing light to disconnect for storage. Gently push back in hole in base to assemble.

How To Open The Lid



Press to open the door latch.
